CA/Browser Forum Patent Advisory Group (PAG) Ballot 182 Conclusion

Date: April 4, 2017

Background: The CA/Browser Forum ("Forum") operates subject to an Intellectual Property Rights Policy v 1.2 effective Feb. 15, 2016 ("IPRP"). As stated in Section 2, one goal of the Forum is to seek to issue Guidelines that can be implemented on a Royalty-Free (RF) basis subject to the conditions of the IPRP.

Under IPRP Section 4, Forum members may exclude certain Essential Claims from CAB Forum RF Licenses. If an Exclusion Notice is filed as described in Section 4 of the IPRP, but the Essential Claim is not available under CAB Forum RF Licensing, a PAG is formed to "resolve the conflict".

The Forum's Ballot 182 proposed certain domain validation methods be added to Baseline Requirements (BR) Section 3.2.2.4, and generated three Exclusion Notices (including amendments) during the Review Period as shown in the table below. In response, this Ballot 182 PAG was formed in January 2017.

PAG Meetings: The PAG met bi-weekly by teleconference call from January 2017 to April 2017. By March, 2017, the three members who had filed Exclusion Notices during the Ballot 182 Review Period all decided to withdraw their Exclusion Notices. See the member Withdrawals for their specific terms. The dates of the Withdrawal of Exclusion Notices are shown in the table below.

4.2 Excluding Patents and/or Patent Applications from Royalty Free Licensing Obligations during Review Period.

Except for Essential Claims encompassed by a Participant's Contributions that are actually incorporated into a Final Guideline or Final Maintenance Guideline approved in accordance with the CAB Forum Guideline approval process, Participants may within the Review Period exclude Essential Claims from the CAB Forum RF License. In such case, Participant shall be permitted to either make an election, (i) not to grant a license or (ii) to provide a license with all of the requirements of Section 5.1 with the exception of subsection 5.1 f.

If a Normative Requirement in a Final Guideline or Final Maintenance Guideline may be fulfilled by any of a list of specified alternatives, then for determination of whether a claim is an Essential Claim, each of the specified alternatives should be considered independently as if it were the only method for fulfilling that requirement. ***
